To undertake classroom teaching ensuring high standards of delivery and outcomes. Be part of the teaching and learning group and use coaching and mentoring to support good quality teaching and learning. Actively support the improvement in outcomes through the delivery of high-quality lessons and masterclasses across the schools. Ensure robust assessments are in place across all key stages.
